## Clatterbridge Cancer Centre Grand Round

The Share2Care and the e-Xchange portal were presented at a really useful Grand Round at The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre on 18<sup>th</sup> November. This meeting had a large multi-professional audience and was recorded to allow the meeting to be broadcast to colleagues who had not been able to attend. We'll circulate a link to this video shortly!

This meeting included an introduction and presentation from the team about S2C, the e-Xchange portal, and where the project is up to. This highlighted information about the latest work to increase the number of Trusts broadcasting and accessing data. We also discussed the overall aim of the project to produce a single digital record that is available to clinicians and to the patient at the point of care.

This introduction was followed by excellent examples of the use and advantages of the system in clinical practice. A number of clinical staff discussed how they have used the system to improve the access to patient information, medication, results from other hospitals and the GP record.

The session ended with a request to attendees to inform their colleagues about the portal and its role. Dr Peter Robson, Consultant Clinical Oncologist at The Clatterbridge Cancer Centre highlighted that they're already starting to ensure that this is communicated via the Acute Oncology service whenever they receive requests for information. They also asked that clinicians when in the MDTs that they attend inform everyone in the Region about the role and benefits of the e-Xchange portal.


